Welcome to Timmins Night Guidelines

Overview

Established in 1994, Welcome to Timmins Night has grown to become the premier event to find community information from local non-profit organizations ranging from municipal services, social clubs, sports and recreation, culture and volunteer organizations.

Welcome to Timmins Night continues to grow and evolve each year. Initially beginning with 30 volunteer organizations and 60 community residents attending, the event now welcomes over 120 participating community organizations and more than 500 attendees.

All members of the community are welcome. Recognizing that the organizations participating are of interest to the whole community and that entry fees may deter or inhibit some from attending, the committee requests that those attending the event bring a non perishable item or a "teddy bear" as their entry fee. All food and soft toys will be collected at the event entrance and donated to the local food bank and the Timmins and District Hospital.

Venue /Date/Time

Welcome to Timmins Night will be held at the McIntyre Curling Club on **September 6**, **2017**. Set up will take place the day of the event; between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm. Booths not set up by 5:00 pm will be subject to forfeiture and may be given to another organization on the waiting list. Each booth will be assigned to a specific themed area (e.g. culture, recreation, health, municipal, and education). Exhibitors will be notified of their booth location in the participation guidelines after the registration deadline. The trade show will be officially open to the public from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm.

Organization Eligibility

Welcome to Timmins Night is a venue for non-profits to market their services and/or increase registration/ participation within your organization/sport/club, etc. <u>Please note that as of this year, exhibitors ARE welcome to sell tangible objects, such as food, merchandise, etc.</u>

Eligibility to participate in Welcome to Timmins Night is as follows:

Non Profit Organizations / Committees / Clubs – all nonprofit organizations/committees/ clubs are deemed eligible to participate in Welcome to Timmins Night as long as they

can demonstrate that they offer free services/classes to the broader community. Qualifying groups may also use Welcome to Timmins Night to recruit volunteers.

Community Health Organizations – community health organizations that provide health information or offer specific programming geared to the health of residents (e.g. Porcupine Health Unit, Senior / Retirement care, Red Cross, etc.)

The Welcome to Timmins Night committee reserves the right to deem organizations/ committees/ clubs as eligible or ineligible.

To maintain the original focus of the Welcome to Timmins Night, organizations are eligible if they are not for profit exclusively, such as non-profit organizations, committees, clubs, and/or community health organizations. A waiting list will be maintained in the event of last minute cancellations, or to fill any open tables.

Registration Process

Organizations / committees/ clubs who wish to participate in Welcome to Timmins Night must complete a registration form and return it the Timmins and District Multicultural Centre.

The number of tables available to an organization will be limited to one, unless the organization delivers more than five unique programs (e.g. Porcupine Health Unit). Then the maximum shall be two tables.



Fee Schedule
